Rates for Membership

Full annual membership fees are due at the beginning of January for each year and are collected direct from your bank. The annual fee is £50 for individual members and £100 for corporate members (applicable to companies with five or more employees) plus a one off joining fee of £20. The annual rate is calculated pro rata for new members joining during the year as follows:
